MEMO TO: Union Locals of Canadian Labour Congress (CLC) Affiliates in the bounds of the Oakville and District Labour Council (ODLC)

ATTN: Presidents, Treasurers and Executive Members

RE: Per Capita Affiliation dues 2025

DATE: January 2025

The Oakville and District Labour Council consists of CLC affiliated Locals working together to build a more equitable society and advocate for workers in our region. We meet on a regular basis to support each other, participate in the CLC and OFL, and to advocate for workers' rights and a progressive society.

This letter is to officially notify your Local of your duties and responsibilities to the Oakville and District Labour Council as outlined in the constitution of the Canadian Labour Congress and the ODLC Bylaws.

From the CLC constitution,

Article 5: Federations and Labour Councils:

- "All affiliates must require their local unions to join federations and labour councils where such exist."
- "All directly chartered locals must affiliate with their federation and labour council."

From the ODLC bylaws:

Article 14: Revenue states:

- "A per capita tax shall be paid upon the full paid up membership for each organization."
- "Each affiliated Local Union, Branch or Lodge shall pay per capita tax of twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per dues paying member per month, with a minimum of \$20.00 per annum."

Dues are payable on a monthly basis for the current *calendar* year for all affiliates. Dues paid on any other basis will be credited to this calendar year, and pro-rated for a 12 month period for purposes of confirming voting delegates at regular meetings. Additional non-voting guests are always welcome.

Please find enclosed an "ODLC Affiliate Dues Form" for your use; dues may be submitted either once per year for the total amount (preferred) or at regular intervals throughout the year. Please forward this information to your treasurers and/or executive. Dues for 2024 (or a first installment) should be received by January 31.
